

VITAL STATISTICS:

Birth Records

- There are no birth records in Ohio prior to 1867
- Microfilmed birth records from 1867-1908 are available in the Local History Room of Coshocton County District Library. There is an index of these records. These records are also available at the Coshocton County Probate Court.
- Birth certificates 1910 to present are available at the Coshocton Public Health District
- Birth certificates for 1909 are available through the Ohio Department of Health (a few certificates exist in 1908, but are mainly records)
- Secretary of State's Office in Washington D.C. should be contacted for those born abroad
- Adoption records should be obtained through the Ohio Department of Vital Statistics

Death Records

- Death records should be obtained from the county where the person's death occurred
- There are no death records in Ohio prior to 1867
- Microfilmed death records from 1867-1908 are available in the Local History Room of Coshocton County District Library. There is an index of these records. These records are also available at the Coshocton County Probate Court.
- Death records and certificates 1908 to present are available at the Coshocton Public Health District
- Death records prior to 1908 can be found at the Coshocton County Probate Court
- Death records and certificates from December 20, 1908- December 31, 1944, are located at the Ohio Historical Society

Marriage Records

- Microfilmed marriage records from 1811-1960 are available in the Local History Room of the Coshocton County District Library. There is an index of these records.
- Marriage records from 1811 to present are available at the Coshocton County Probate Court

Estate Records

- Microfilmed estate records from 1811-1960 are available in the Local History Room of the Coshocton County District Library. There is an index for these records.
- Estate records from 1811 to present are available at the Coshocton County Probate Court

Deeds and Land Records

- The following microfilmed records are available at Coshocton County District Library
 - Tax records from the early 1800's through 1881
 - Deed records from 1800-1843
 - The Grantors and Grantees General Index to Deeds 1800-1907
- A complete collection of records is available through the Coshocton County Recorder's Office
