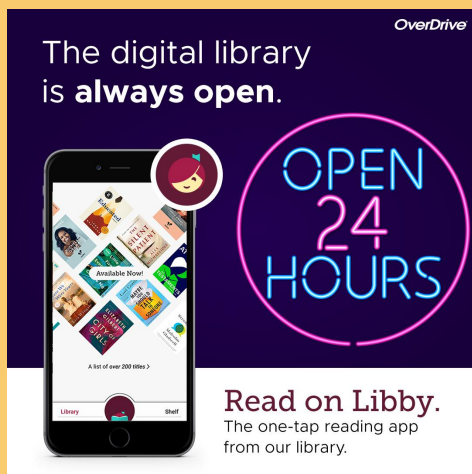
TECH TIP

Are you familiar with this scenario? You hear about a "must-read" and you visit the library to borrow the title. Unfortunately, the print title is not available. The reference librarian places a hold on the print title for you and the wait begins. Some time passes and you receive a call that the print title you placed a hold on is available, but you've long forgotten about it.

"Must-read" titles can move quickly, resulting in wait time for patrons. With a Coshocton Public Library card, patrons have access to two FREE and unique digital collections: [The Ohio Digital Library](#) and [Hoopla](#). Sometimes the "must-read" title you are looking for is available to you digitally in these collections with a shorter wait time, or in some cases, no wait at all.
