Chi Classes

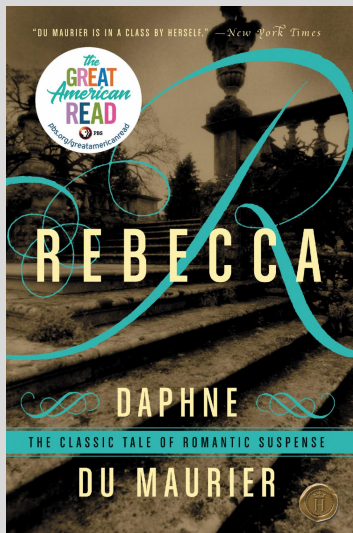
